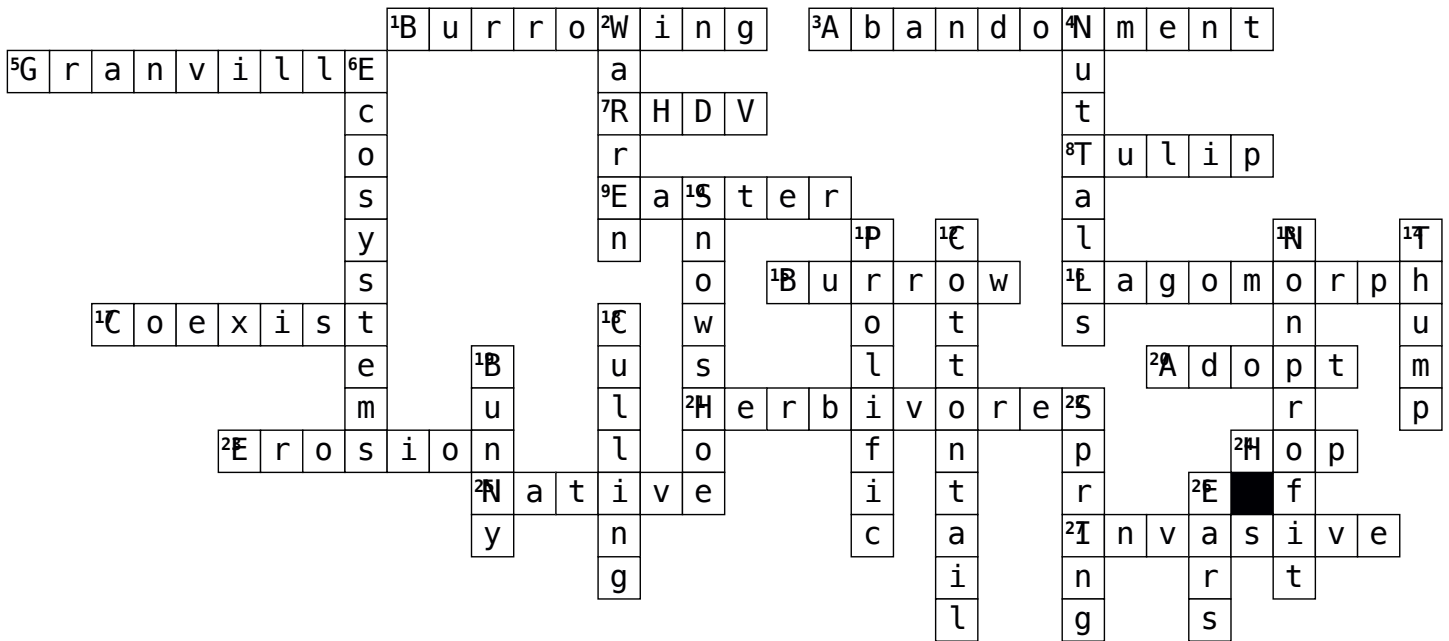


A Cottontail Crossword
